

## **Customs regulations**

## Household goods can be imported duty free providing that:

- 1. All items (incl car) have been in the use and possession of the immigrant for at least 6 month
- 2. The immigrant continues to keep all items for his own and personal use
- 3. The importation takes place during the 1 year period of transfer of the residence
- 4. Any foreseen subsequent consignment must be reported and listed at the time of the first importation

## Required documentation to be supplied prior to importation:

- 1. Immigrants personal customs declaration (Customs form 18.44)
- 2. Detailed inventory of the goods . New itmes must be listed and valued separately on the inventory
- 3. Photostat copy of the passports basic data
- 4. Lease or property title of the residence in Switserland
- 5. The Swiss residence permit (or equivalent official certificate)

## Additional documentation for foreigners only:

Work/residence permit issued by the local competent authorities
