

Disclaimer Regarding Vehicle Imports into Italy

Please note that the customs clearance process for importing a vehicle (car or motorcycle) into Italy under duty-free conditions is entirely separate from the subsequent eligibility of that vehicle for registration with Italian license plates.

While a vehicle may be successfully imported without incurring customs duties, this does **not** automatically guarantee that it can be registered for road use in Italy. The responsibility lies solely with the vehicle owner to verify, in advance, the specific requirements for registration with the ACI (Automobile Club d'Italia) and the Public Vehicle Registry (PRA - Pubblico Registro Automobilistico).

These requirements often include, but are not limited to:

- Technical documentation from the original manufacturer abroad.
- Proof of compliance with European homologation standards.
- Possible modifications to the bodywork or engine to meet local regulations.
- Regional variations in documentation or procedural requirements.

The decision to import a vehicle should not be based solely on customs duty exemptions, but must also consider:

- The total cost of shipping.
- Potential expenses for technical modifications.
- The feasibility and cost of registration in the intended region of residence.

Failure to meet registration requirements may result in significant delays, additional costs, or the inability to legally use the vehicle on Italian roads.
