Import Procedures - Duty Free

A. Foreign Nationals

Only a full 1 year work permit will be considered for duty exemption.
Original passport + work permit must be presented during inspection.
Bond facility is not available pending issuance of work permit.

Documents required for customs clearance

- Original Passport
- Original 1-Year Work Permit
- Original Bill of Lading (express release / surrendered)
- Packing List
- Authorized Letter and Customs Entry Form (prepared by us)

Important Notes

- Shipper should enter Thailand with 90 days "Type B" (business) Non-Immigrant Visa
- Household goods must arrive within six (6) months after his/her first arrival on their non-immigrant visa.
- Household goods must come from the country in which he/she has been working before moving to Thailand.
- Must contain only used household and personal effect items (no new items).

B. Thai Nationals

Thai nationals who have been living overseas for more than one year will be considered for Duty Exemption.

Frequent travel back and forth may cause Customs to deem the owner to have not been permanently based in the origin country.

Each visit to Thailand must not be more than 3 months each time.

Shipper must have never imported goods into Thailand.

Original passport + previous passport along with an Original Thai ID Card are required, to be presented during inspection.

If no entry stamps is shown in the passport, shipper will have to get an Immigration record upon arrival in Bangkok.

Documents required for customs clearance

- Original Passport and possibly previous passport
- Original Thai ID Card and copy of a house certificate
- Original Bill of Lading (express release / surrendered)
- Packing List
- Immigration Travel Record (where applicable)
- Authorized Letter and Customs Entry Form

Important Notes

- Valid Thai passport
 - Household goods must arrive within (6) months after his/her first arrival.
 - The shipper must have been in the origin country for at least one (1) year.
 - If the shipper visits Thailand too many times during his/her stay overseas, he/she may have to explain why and it is at the discretion of Thai Customs to grant them Duty Free entry.

General Information (Foreign Nationals & Thai Returning Nationals)

- Thai Customs allows one of each kind of electrical appliances.
- Double items will be dutiable as well as other certain items:
Toys, baby items, bicycles, rugs, sport equipment, golf sets.
- Certain luxury items including crystal glasses and porcelain vases, fax machines are all dutiable and are not considered by Customs for duty exemption especially coming in via Air Freight.
- Customs will allow duty free import for only one (1) sea shipment and one (1) small air shipment.

Timeline for Customs Clearance

- Approximately 5-7 working days.
- The estimated clearance time-frame is based on having ALL complete Documentation available at the time of the shipment's arrival.

C. Diplomatic Shipments

- Documentation processing for diplomatic shipments typically takes approximately 2-4 weeks by the respective embassy after the shipment arrives at port.
- It is therefore imperative that we receive all necessary documentation as early as possible prior to the shipment's arrival.
- This allows us to review the documents and forward them to the embassy to determine whether the consignee is eligible to obtain Diplomatic Status (DP1).

Documents required for customs clearance

- Original Bill of Lading (express release / surrendered)
- Packing List
- DP1 document from the Embassy (obtainable after shipment arrival at port)
- Authorized letter and customs entry form

Timeline for Customs Clearance

- It will take approximately 2-4 weeks to obtain DP1 status after the shipment arrives at the airport or seaport.
- Once all documents are supplied to us, it will take approximately 3-4 working days to clear an air shipment through customs, and 3-5 working days to clear a full container load (FCL) or small LCL sea shipment.
- The estimated time schedule is based on complete documentation being available at the time of shipment arrival and assumes normal customs clearance procedures.

Restricted / Dutiable Items

- Wine, spirits, foodstuffs
(must not be included in the shipment without prior consultation)
- Baby items, including toys
- Alcohol
- Antiques and objects of art
(permission from the Fine Arts Department is required)
- Office items and equipment
- Sport equipment, including golf sets
- Music instruments, including pianos
- Luxury items, including crystal and porcelain, and carpets
- Fireworks (permission from the Ministry of Interior)
- Wild flora, fauna, fish, and other aquatic fauna
(permission from the National Park, Wildlife and Plant Conservation Department / Department of Agriculture / or Department of Fishery is required)
- Buddha statues and relics require import permits

Prohibited Items

- Shortwave radios
- Pornographics or obscene objects, literature, pictures, etc.
- Counterfeit currency, bonds, coins or other counterfeit objects
- Medical equipment without a license
- Gold and silver
- Buddha heads / non full figure buddha article or religious items
- Firearms, ammunition
