

Customs Information the Netherlands

Conditions

This information is provided as summarized information to help you understand and prepare the duty free import of your removal, if possible.

Actual information and final decision on duty free import is by discretion of the customs department / finance ministry in the country of destination. You should always check at the embassy / consulate in your country of origin or at the customs offices in your country of destination, to be well prepared.

Used household goods/personal effects can be imported duty free, if

- The owner has lived outside the European union for at least 12 months
- The Owner brings his normal residence to the Netherlands
- Household goods have been used for at least 6 months, and are still intended for personal use
- Shipment must arrive within one year of the customer's arrival in the Netherlands
- You will not lent, pawn, or rent your goods out within 12 month after they were imported into the Netherlands

Documents that are required

- Copy of identification pages from passport
- Application form (attached)
- A complete, comprehensive Inventory list in English or in Dutch
- Copy of certificate of registration of the municipality in the Netherlands where you are going to live
- Copy of rental agreement or purchase contract of the residence, at origin and destination
- Copy of work contract or an declaration of your employer, origin and destination
