



## Import of Household goods and personal effects – Guide 2023

### Republic of Croatia

#### **Returning Croatian citizens**

##### Documents required

- National passport
- Power of Attorney
- Valued Inventory List
- Croatian ID card
- Certificate from employer in country of departure confirming residence period outside of Europe or a certificate of temporary residence abroad issued by the competent diplomatic mission or consular office of the Republic of Croatia abroad

#### **Other European citizens / Foreigners (Non- European citizens)**

##### Documents required

- National passport
- Power of Attorney
- Valued Inventory List
- Croatian ID card for foreign residents
- Home rental contract in Croatia
- Employment contract in Croatia (if applicable)
- Certificate from employer in country of departure confirming residence period outside of Europe or a certificate of temporary residence abroad issued by the competent diplomatic mission or consular office of the Republic of Croatia abroad



### Diplomats

#### Documents required

- Diplomatic passport
- Diplomatic protocol of importation
- Diplomatic ID card
- Inventory list

### Motor Vehicles

#### Documents required

- Original registration documents
- Invoice or Pro-forma invoice with vehicle's value
- All technical information (chassis number, weight, power, etc.)

### Pets

#### Documents required

- ID by tag, tattoo, or microchip
- Valid passport for pet animals
- Veterinarian's certificate

(all pets will be inspected at the border by a certified veterinarian)

### Specific Information

- Duties and taxes of approximately 35-45% of the total value apply if the owner of the goods does not qualify for duty- and tax-free import. (Final amount determined by customs authorities).
