COMMENCEMENT OF EMPLOYMENT

The terms of this agreement are effective from **1 March 2020** or later, dependent on the employees availability and provided that a valid work visa is available.

POSITION, DUTIES AND PLACE OF WORK

The annual base salary shall be **USD 200'000**, payable 26 times a year in accordance with the Company's ordinary salary routines.






