• Lowest Bill of Lading level, i.e. House Bill or Regular Bill

- Name and address(es) or the physical location(s) where the goods were stuffed into container. For break bulk shipments, the name and address(es) of the physical location(s) where the goods made "ship ready" must be provided.
- The "scheduled" stuffing location may be provided.
- This may be the same name/address as the manufacturer (supplier).

## <sup>3</sup>Consolidator (Stuffer Name/Address)

- Name and address of the party who stuffed the container or arranged for the stuffing of the container. For break bulk shipments, the name and address of the party who made the goods "ship ready" must be provided.
- If no consolidator is used e.g. "factory load" shipments, provide the name/address of the manufacturer (supplier).
- A widely recognized commercially acceptable identification number for this party may be provided in lieu of the name and address.
   CBP will accept a DUNS number in lieu of the name and address.
