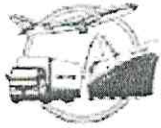

About your application for Transfer of Residence (ToR) relief

Thank you for your application for ToR relief.

We have approved your application and given you the following Unique Reference Number (URN), 03413123.

Your URN only covers imports which arrive in the UK from 15/07/2023 to 15/07/2024

What you need to do now

You need to now complete an import declaration if the goods that you're bringing to the United Kingdom are entering the country separately to your arrival. If you are using a shipper or agent to assist with your move, you need to give your URN to them so they can make an import declaration on your behalf.

This authorisation also allows you, or persons acting on your behalf, the ability to use the appropriate Special Combined-nomenclature Code outlined in Chapter 99 of the Tariff of the United Kingdom reference document when completing a written or electronic import declaration. This will allow you to use this single code to declare all your household effects, with the exclusion of excise goods or those subject to any prohibition or restriction.

Restricted goods will need to be identified separately on the import declaration, in case of Border Force inspection.

You are responsible for telling your agent or shipper if you are importing any goods which are not covered by this relief.

Notification of vehicle arrival

If you are importing a vehicle into the UK, you must make a Notification of Vehicle Arrival (NOVA) application once the vehicle has arrived in the UK. To do this, email:

- your full name
- your address
- your URN
- a copy of your official vehicle details - certificate of title and date of vehicle arrival to ecsm.nhcars@hmrc.gov.uk or ring us on 0300 322 7071 for advice.

Please put 'NOVA application' in the subject heading on the email.

The legislation used to make our decision is The Customs (Reliefs from a Liability to Import Duty and Miscellaneous Amendments) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 - Section 1.

Corresponding with HMRC by email

Use the following information to decide whether you want to deal with us by email. We take the security of personal information very seriously. Email is insecure, so it's very important that you understand the risks before you email us. We'll not deal with you by email unless you tell us you accept the risks of doing so.

About the risks

The main risks associated with using email that concern HMRC are:

- confidentiality and privacy – there's a risk that emails sent over the internet may be intercepted
- confirming your identity – it's crucial that we only communicate with established contacts at their correct email addresses
- there's no guarantee that an email received over an insecure network, like the internet, hasn't been altered during transit
- attachments could contain a virus or malicious code

How we can reduce the risks
