Financial support evidence not required.
Return/onward ticket not required.
Stay subject to grant of entry permission.
The holder may only work as General Physician in Canterbury for Health New Zealand.
Must be paid at or above \$ 108.66 per hour.
Must provide evidence of remuneration if requested.
You must leave before visa expiry or face deportation.
May not be placed in a triangular employment arrangement with a controlling third party.

If you do not comply with these conditions you may become liable for deportation.

Maximum continuous stay

While on an Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV), you have a maximum continuous stay.

You do not require a visa label in your passport

You must not remain in New Zealand after your visa expires

You must hold a valid visa at all times while you are in New Zealand. If you do not hold a valid visa, you will be in New Zealand unlawfully and you will be liable for deportation. If you do not leave voluntarily before you are served with a deportation order you will face a prohibition period preventing your return to New Zealand in the future.

Your employment rights

You have the same minimum rights as any other worker in New Zealand, including the right to public holidays, leave, work breaks, wages and written employment agreements.

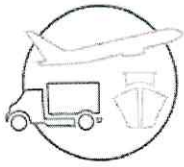
